

ARTICLE _____ MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS

Section 1. Annual Meeting. The annual meeting of the Post shall be held each year at a time and place to be fixed by a majority of the Post Executive Committee. Notice shall be provided in accordance with Section 6.

Section 2. Regular Meetings. Regular meetings of the Post shall be held at the club rooms on _____, at which may be transacted such business as may properly be brought up for action; such meetings may be converted into entertainment meetings, as may be deemed advisable by the officers of the Post.

Section 3. Special Meetings. The Post Commander or a majority of the Executive Committee may call a special meeting of the Post. Upon the written request of _____ members, the committee shall call a special meeting of the Post. Notice of special meetings shall be provided in accordance with Section 6.

Section 4. Quorum. As many Post Members as are in actual attendance at a Membership meeting duly noticed and held shall constitute a quorum.

Section 5. Rules of Order. Except where inconsistent with these bylaws, the Post Commander or the Post Commander's designee shall determine the order of business and procedure at the meetings of this Post, including such regulation of the manner of voting and the conduct of business as seems to him or her to be in order, subject to the will of a majority of the Members in attendance at the meeting on any point of order.

Section 6. Notice. Written notice stating the place, day and hour of the Annual meeting of Members or any subsequent notice about the meeting shall be deliver to each Member not less than ten (10) nor more than sixty (60) calendar days before the date of the Annual meeting. Notice of the Annual or Special Meetings may be in person, by email, or by faxing the notice to the address, email address or facsimile number supplied by the Member.

Section 7. Remote Meetings. An annual, regular, or special meeting of the Post Members is not required to be held at a geographic location if the meeting is held by means of the internet or other electronic communications technology in a manner pursuant to which the Members have the opportunity to read or head the proceedings substantially concurrent with the occurrence of the proceedings, vote on matters submitted to the members, pose questions, and make comments.
